

Dear Jason and Staff,


We first attended the National College Planners Workshop in September 2011, which was the beginning of our son's second year at Moorpark College. We were worried we'd waited too long to learn about college financing options when we realized most everyone in the room had children still in high school. We had researched college planning/financing and had talked to many parents and students who *seemed* to know the best ways to go about it, but we ended up more and more confused as time went by. We didn't know what to do! During the Workshop you assured us it wasn't too late, and by the time we left you had given us so much information and answered so many questions that for the first time we felt positive about our son's future.

When our son decided his career choice would mean many years of higher education we were afraid he would end up drowning in debt before his career even started. From our first meeting with you we felt that our son's future college plans were possible without devastating debt at the end.

We can't put into words what a relief it is having NCP filing the FAFSA and other financial aid forms. To date, **our son has received approximately \$13,000 in financial aid** towards Moorpark College.

Jason, we truly appreciate all the guidance you've given us in making decisions and navigating the confusing world of college. Your staff is extremely helpful in the application process and always available to answer questions. Our son has a long way to go, but knowing you're there to help us gives us the confidence his plans will come true.
