He has helped both of my girls receive maximum financial aid and he helped the overwhelming process go smoothly the entire time.


My oldest daughter, Alexis, is currently attending the Art Institute of San Francisco and was not receiving any financial aid. **After working with Jason, she received a maximum Pell Grant and State Grant money. She received \$19,000 per year and will only be attending for three years, as she came in as a transfer student. This totals to \$57,000 of free grant money that she will never have to pay back.**

I also had NCP work with my youngest daughter, Lacey, who is currently attending Moorpark College. She will be transferring to CSU Channel Islands in the Fall of 2014. **She was able to secure \$5,500 in grant money at Moorpark for two years, which has resulted in \$11,000 of free money. She will be receiving double when she transfers to CSU Channel Islands next fall.**

I am so grateful for this experience with Jason. He is always available to answer questions, give constructive feedback, and provide perspective for my family to make the best decision for our daughters in their educational career. He is always patient and makes this complicated process much simpler and more enjoyable.
